

### **Who we are:**

The Survivor Advocacy Outreach Program (SAOP) empowers the community and all survivors to live free of sexual violence, domestic violence, human trafficking, and stalking. Our vision is a world where everyone has the support to live a safe life free of violence. SAOP has been in existence for over 10 years and serves 9 counties in the Southeast Ohio region and is expanding its reach and programs to include crisis intervention, residential services, and social enterprise divisions.

### **The Opportunity:**

The Survivor Advocacy Outreach Program is seeking a skilled clinician, supervisor, and administrator with extensive therapy experience to act as our **Clinical Director** in our Athens, OH office. The goal of this position is to develop a successful and sustainable counseling program. The Clinical Director is responsible for providing clinical leadership and policy direction for all treatment programs; including Mental Health Assessment, Crisis Intervention, Behavioral Health Counseling and Therapy, Therapeutic Behavioral Services and Community Supportive Psychiatric Therapy Services.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Plan, implement, administer, coordinate, monitor and evaluate the specific programs, functions, services, and activities of Counseling, including operating policies and procedures.
- Conduct initial assessment, ongoing client care, and client education.
- Document all counseling and education services, assessments, reassessments, referrals, and follow-up in the client's clinical record.
- Provide clinical documentation and assure that all filing of clinical information and submission of Medicaid billing information is done accurately and within the time frame required.
- Provide coordination of support services for the client/family and record the services provided in the client's clinical record.
- Facilitate needed interventions for crisis-oriented issues utilizing a multi-disciplinary team approach for assigned clients.
- Ensure accountability of treatment program and client compliance through collaboration.

### **Desired Qualifications:**

- Minimum of a Masters Degree with emphasis in Counseling, Psychology or equivalent.
- 10 years experience in therapeutic trauma intervention techniques, crisis intervention.
- Working knowledge/expertise of trauma/ survivorship or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Experience building a clinical program.
- LPC or LPCC in the state of Ohio.
- Familiarity with accreditation and the ability to obtain accreditation for billing.
- Valid driver's license, clean driving record, and vehicle suitable for transportation.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Knowledge of sexual victimization and survivor services.
- EMDR certified or willing to obtain certification within 6 months.
